EOPS ELIGIBILITY



- ▶ Full time student at NVC (12 units)
- ▶ California Resident (including AB540 students)
- ▶ Completed less than 70 degree applicable units from all colleges attended
 - ▶ Apply for financial aid (FAFSA or CA Dream Act),
and be income eligible with $SAI \leq 0$
- ▶ Educational disadvantage (First generation, non-native English speaker, NVC equity group)

COOPERATIVE AGENCIES RESOURCES FOR EDUCATION

The **CARE** program provides additional services to EOPS students who are **single, head-of-household parents, receiving CalWORKs or TANF cash aid benefits**

Eligibility:

Submit an EOPS application

Be single and head of the household parent

Be themselves or their children receiving county benefits

Enroll in at least 12 units at NVC

The **NextUp** program provides supplemental services to EOPS students who are **current and/or former foster youth** attending Napa Valley College

Eligibility:

Submit an EOPS application or NextUp Application

Be a current or former foster youth on or after their 13th birthday

Be under 26 years of age before July 1st of the academic year in which the student enrolls in the program

Working towards enrollment in 9 units at NVC

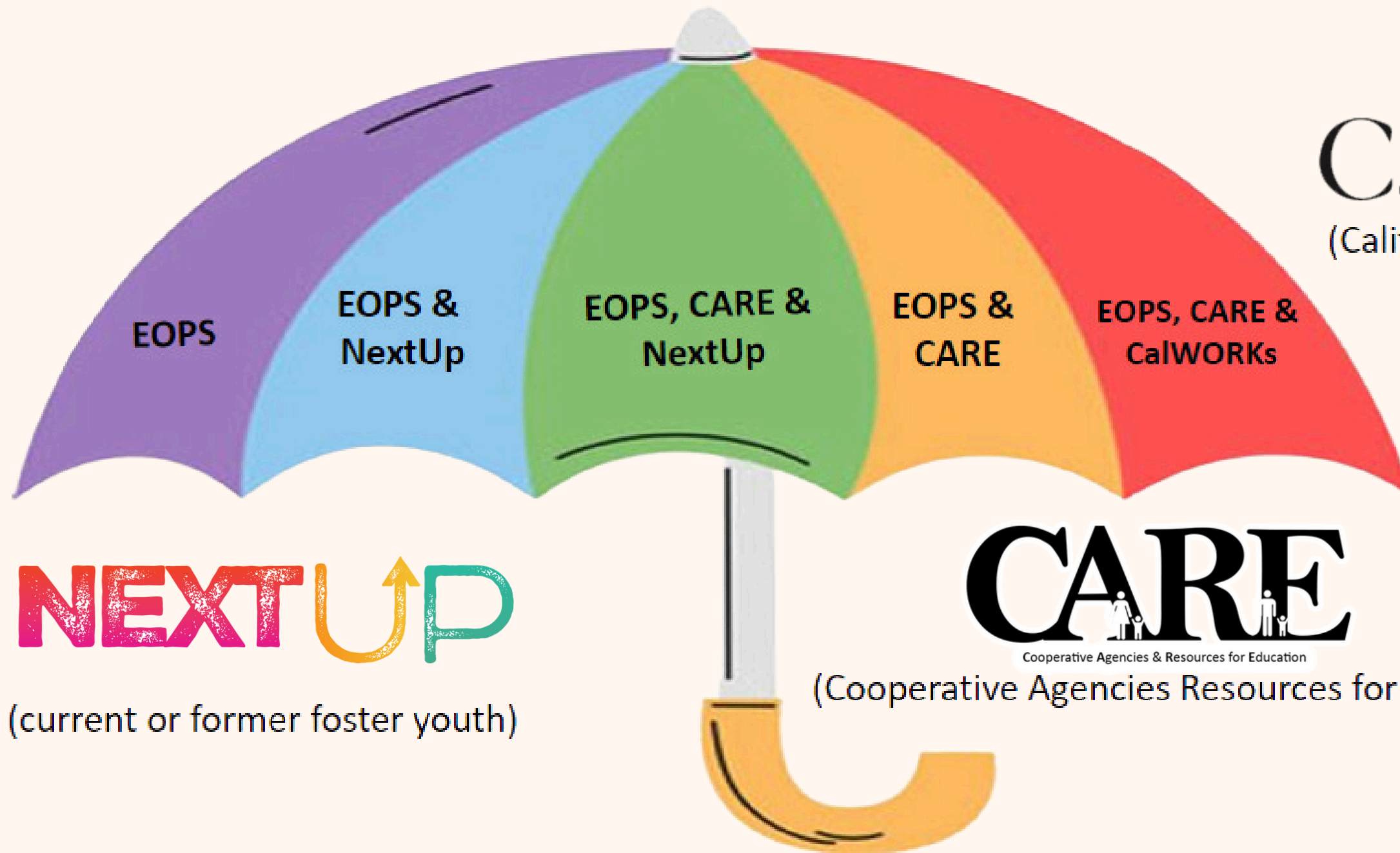
